Alberta Ed requires that schools have proof of students registered at our school with proper documentation. The secretary will be required to make at least 3 attempts to acquire the proper ID. The first 2 attempts will be by mail and the 3rd a phone call. In the event the parent still does not have the identification after the 3 attempts, they will be asked to fill out a waiver form.

The waiver document will be asking that the parents declare that they do not have the following forms of ID. In most cases it is a Alberta birth certificate. The parent will need to fill out the parental statement and sign at the bottom.

We are required to do this each year for a all students that do not have the requested identification.
